First Holy Communion 2022

Children currently in Year 3-6 are invited to make their First Confession and First Holy Communion in 2022. If you feel your child is ready to receive these sacraments, please fill in this form and return it to the Parish Office, c/o 4 Harley Street, Bath BA1 2SF along with a copy of the child's baptism certificate. The copy of the baptismal certificate is not necessary if your child was baptised at St Mary's.

- The Sacrament of Reconciliation (First Confession) will take place at St Mary's Church in April, and the children will make their First Holy Communion at St Mary's Church in May/June.
- We ask that children be brought to Mass each Sunday, and they are very welcome to take part in our popular Children's Liturgy at 10.30am Mass. They are also welcome to become altar servers.
- There will be a meeting for all parents/guardians in St Mary's Parish Centre on Tuesday 8th March, at 7.00pm, led by Fr Jeremy. It is very important that at least one parent/guardian attends this meeting. You will find out details of children's preparation classes, the parents' preparation classes, receiving the Sacraments and choosing a date for our child's First Holy Communion. The children will each need an "I Belong" book which will be available that evening, costing £8.50 (cash please). Each child, including siblings, needs their own copy of the book.
- Due to COVID restrictions, there will be two preparation courses: one at St Mary's Primary School for pupils at the school, and one at St Mary's Church for those not at the school.
Children attending St Mary's School: Five preparation sessions will take place in school with Mrs Pecchia. Dates and times tbc.
Children not attending St Mary's School: Four preparation sessions will take place straight after Sunday 10.30am Mass in the parish centre, lasting 45 mins whilst parents have a coffee with other parishioners. Most of the course will be focused on home study with the parents, using the "I Belong" book. Dates: 20th March, 27th March, 10th April, 8th May.
- It is important that children and parents take part in all parts of the preparation course. However, if your child is unwell on the day of a session or Mass, please contact Fr Jeremy Rigden (01225 311725) or Charlotte Boyall in St Mary's Parish Office (01225 314114/ bath.stmary@cliftondiocese.com) as soon as possible, or Mrs Pecchia if they miss a school preparation session.
