

## ASSISTED DYING

Next Wednesday (24<sup>th</sup> January) Kit Malthouse MP will table a ten-minute rule bill. The details of this are not yet known, but it is likely to say in effect that the House of Commons wishes that there should be legislation to allow assisted suicide and/or euthanasia.
